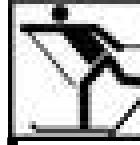

# The Montriond Lake

Head to « The Big North » with this itinerary which alternate snowed up clearings and passages in the underwoods.

You will start going along the Montriond Lake, third biggest lake of Haute-Savoie. In this season, you will appreciate its frozen extend, surrounded by forests and cliffs where numerous small frozen waterfalls spurt out.

Reached the end of the lake, you will go through the underwoods towards the village of The Alber-

tans with its wooden chalets covered with white gold.

The most courageous will be able to extend the circuit with one of the two proposed loops, before going back to the lake.

*In order that every activity can be practised in good conditions, respect the marked track for the snowshoe trekking and the pedestrians .*
