

The « Char des Quais » Walk



WALKING in
VALLÉE
d'AULPS

From the Col de la Basse, start walking down to the Praz hamlet. At the sign "Les Pâquis" (1475 m), follow the path on your right. After climbing up about 5 minutes the path goes down through alpine pastures to the Col de l'Encrenaz.

A very nice view over the Mont-Blanc and the surrounding summits. A walk with not much total vertical climb which is nonetheless already high in altitude. Park at the Col de l'Encrenaz (4 km from Côte d'Arbroz). You find there the only drinking water point of the walk.

The more courageous can climb up to the top of the Char des Quais. It requires 10 minutes more walking.

Start from the Col de l'Encrenaz. Follow the path behind the refreshment room (L'Encrenaz Bar) and start climbing, direction Col de la Basse (you'll need 50m for only 200m of vertical climb) through alpine pastures. At the Col de la Basse stop a moment and enjoy
