The path snakes its way up abruptly through the woods and reaches the Guéritolles chalets. The word Guéritolles is an old French word which means mountain meadow. This place used to be grazing land with chalets but it hasn't been used for a long time. The chalets are now ruins.

Through trees you get a glance at the Vallée d'Aulps: in the foreground: Montirond village and its church with its strange steeple dedicated to the Pied-mont-Sardinia kings. In the middle ground, stand the 3 main summits of Morzine: Ressachaux, the Pointe de Nyon and the Pléney which all have ski lifts.

Keep on walking until you cross a river bed. Here there are 2 possibilities: either you take the left path which leads to the Pointe de Nantaux (this path is very steep, not well marked and can be dangerous: it takes 3h30 to reach the top of the Pointe de Nantaux) or you take the right one. This one snakes its way through woods and will allow you to reach the Pas hamlet. There you get back on the tarmac road which has to be followed for 700m to join Les Granges hamlet.

From the centre of Montirond Village drive towards Thonon, 150 m before the Plagnettes bridge, turn right (direction "le Lac"). 300m further on is located "Les Granges" hamlet. Park your car where possible.

In Les Granges hamlet don't miss to give a glance at the traditional buildings: little chalets named "mazots" (they used to be built to shelter family's treasures) and chalets. The path starts on the right at the end of the hamlet. It climbs up steadily during 5 minutes and then it skirts round the edge of the woods before turning on
